#### 1. Introduction

As part of the implementation of the *First Nations Land Management Act* for the ?akis'qnuk First Nation Reserve, the Surveyor General Branch (SGB) has prepared a Land Description describing the extent of the Reserve lands as required under Section 6.1(a) of the Act for Columbia Lake Indian Reserve No. 3.

Outstanding issues related to the jurisdictional boundaries of the Reserve or to the Land Description contained in this Report are explained in Section 4.

The Land Description contained in Section 2 deals with the extent of the Reserve lands that will be subject to the Land Code of the ?akis'qnuk First Nation under the *First Nations Land Management Act* and is not intended to prejudice any of this First Nation's claim(s) to lands beyond the Reserve.

The Land Description is based on a review of the Indian Lands Registry and other documents pertaining to the extent of title to the Reserve. The Land Description is not a legal interpretation of those documents. As there may be different legal interpretations of the documents, legal assistance may be required to determine the nature of the legal interests. The content of this Land Description is accurate based on the documents reviewed; however, there may be other documents that were not found or uncovered that may affect the extent of the title to the Reserve.

### 2. Land Description

#### Columbia Lake Indian Reserve No. 3

A) Land Description of the Extent of Reserve Lands that will be subject to the Land Code of the ?akis'qnuk First Nation under the First Nations Land Management Act.

Reserve Lands within the Province of British Columbia, Canada In Kootenay District, more particularly described as:

All of Columbia Lake Indian Reserve No. 3 with the rectilinear boundaries shown on Plans BC49 and 105789 with portions of Plan BC49 having been subsequently resurveyed and recorded as Plans 57895, 53713, 56924, 105739, 105749 and the natural boundary shown on Plan 105789 recorded in the Canada Lands Surveys Records (CLSR).

Save and except all those portions of Columbia Lake Indian Reserve No. 3 more particularly described as:

Firstly: Kootenay Number 3 Road shown on Plan 2512A CLSR.

Secondly: Kootenay Highway shown on Plan 52354 CLSR.

Thirdly: Lot 1 shown on Plan 53280 CLSR.

Fourthly: Statutory Right of Way for Highway as shown on Plan 70305 CLSR.

Fifthly: Lot 245, Plan 105739 CLSR.

Sixthly: Lot 35-4 and Lot 44-4-1, Plan 105749 CLSR.

Total Lands containing by admeasurement 3404 hectares, (8,412acres) more or less.

#### The above described Reserve Lands are subject to:

The rights and reservations contained in provincial Order in Council 1938-1036, registered in the Indian Lands Registry as No 8042, transferring the land from the Province of British Columbia to Canada, as amended by provincial Order in Council 1969-1555, registered in the Indian Lands Registry as No 4111-118.

B) Land Description of the extent of reserve lands that will not be subject to the Land Code of the ?akis'qnuk First Nation and which have been excluded under Section 7 of the First Nations Land Management Act.

Reserve Lands within the Province of British Columbia, Canada In Kootenay District, more particularly described as:


Firstly: Lot 245 shown on Plan 105739 CLSR.


Secondly: Lot 35-4 and Lot 44-4-1 shown on Plan 105749 CLSR.

- 5. The natural boundary of the Columbia River and Windermere Lake form the natural boundary of the Reserve. The location of the natural boundary was updated in 2015 by Plan 105789 CLSR. The location of the natural boundary may continue to move and the associated areas may change in the future.
